Request for Proposal

The Metis Settlements General Council invites you to submit a proposal, including references, for the following project:

The Metis Settlements General Council is looking for two (2) experienced and qualified individuals to travel to 7 of the 8 Settlements or surrounding community(ies) and facilitate Community Engagement Sessions on the **Collaborative Process on Indian Registration**. The *Truth and Reconciliation Calls to Action* and the implementation of the *United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples* support the elimination of the Indian Act, which is outdated and reflects 19th century colonial assumptions about Indigenous People. The Government of Canada wants to work with effected individuals with this Collaborative Approach to find the best way to address Indian Act Registration issues.

Indian Act Registration affects the Metis Settlements via Section 75 and 90 of the Metis Settlements Act.

Objective

The Government of Canada wants to hear from Metis Settlement members how the Indian Act amendments and proposed amendments will affect Settlement members.

The successful proposal will include a brief summary on your background and how it relates to the project/subject matter as well as a quote outlining all expenses including travel.

The successful applicant will be responsible for the following:

- Preparation, facilitation, and note taking of all meetings and materials
- Be able to host 2 sessions per Settlement (if necessary) (for 7 Settlements and 1 session in Edmonton)
- Adhere to the Collaborative Process – Consultation Guide (will be provided)
- Must have own equipment such as laptop
- All their own travel arrangements

Deliverables:

- Must have own reliable vehicle and valid Class 5 Driver's License
- Must be able to complete the sessions by **March 15, 2019**
- Must be able to provide a written report by **March 22, 2019**

Note:

- Small budget for supplies can be provided

We would like 1 facilitator to host 4 sessions in the East (Buffalo Lake, Kikino, Elizabeth and Edmonton) and 1 facilitator to host 4 Sessions in the West (East Prairie, Peavine, Gift Lake (or High Prairie) & Paddle Prairie or (High Level/Peace River)). **Please indicate which sessions you are proposing to host. We will also consider 1 facilitator per Settlement.**
